**STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE OF DEBTORS'
COMPLAINT FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AND VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL
WITHOUT PREJUDICE OF DEBTORS' MOTION FOR A PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION STAYING THE PROSECUTION OF A CERTAIN NON-
BANKRUPTCY COURTPROCEEDING PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 362(a) AND
105(a) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AND 28 U.S.C. SECTION 1334**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), made applicable to these proceedings by Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 7041, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. On July 10, 2009, LandAmerica Financial Group, Inc. and LandAmerica 1031 Exchange Services, Inc. (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed their Adversary Complaint for Injunctive Relief Pursuant to Sections 362(a) and 105(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Rules 7001(7) and 7065 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and 28 U.S.C. Sections 157 and 1334 (the “Complaint”), against the above captioned Defendants thereby commencing this Adversary Proceeding.

2. On July 10, 2009, the Debtors filed their Motion for a Preliminary Injunction Staying the Prosecution of a Certain Non-Bankruptcy Court Proceeding Pursuant to Sections 362(a) and 105(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and 28 U.S.C. Section 1334 (the “Motion”).

3. On November 10, 2009, the Court entered its Order Granting Debtors’ Motion for Order Approving Stipulation Governing the Production of Confidential Materials (Docket No. 2516)

4. By agreement of all parties, the Complaint is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** and the Motion is **VOLUNTARILY WITHDRAWN WITHOUT PREJUDICE.**
